

## Fostering development



The day care facilities (SEA) of Elisabeth offer more than just care.

In our nine crèches, we stimulate the development of emotional, social, cognitive, motoric and creative skills through specific and targeted support, based on the Pikler pedagogy.

The concept of multilingualism is implemented in all our nurseries, as well as the concept of inclusion, which allows us to welcome in our SEA every child, regardless of their specific needs.

Our twelve “maisons relais” are specialized in the care of school children (3-12 years old). Here, the children find a safe atmosphere that is beneficial to their well-being. Through a variety of situations and constructive suggestions, they can gain valuable experience. Their creative participation is stimulated and responsible behaviour is encouraged.



Our six youth centres offer places of exchange and encounters for young people aged 12 to 26. Here they can discover their interests, shape their identity and develop their social, cultural and cognitive skills.

All the offers of our youth centres aim to strengthen the autonomy of young people and invite them to take responsibility for their actions.

The young people experience what it means to be tolerant, respectful and part of a community.

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## Fostering development



### elisabeth Kanner-a Familjenhëllef

The day and night facilities are intended for children, adolescents and families in difficult life situations. The application for admission is made by the juvenile court judge, but we also take in young people in distress on a voluntary basis.

For each baby, child and young person we care for, we draw up an individual support plan, which guides the daily work of our teams. Depending on the needs of the young person, specific therapeutic, socio-educational, psychological and medical care is provided.

The primary goal of our commitment is to enable the child or the young person to return to his or her family of origin, which is involved in this process from the very beginning, according to their will and possibilities.

Thus our child protection services, respectively our socio-familial primary boarding school, offer holistic and

comprehensive care for the child in his or her particular situation, support the parents in their re-education efforts and help them reorganize their life situation.

Since 2015, when a large number of war refugees arrived in Luxembourg, elisabeth has set up a reception centre for young unaccompanied minors. In these residential groups, the focus is on intercultural learning while respecting the beliefs and practices of the young people welcomed.

Our SIPO service offers individual outpatient services for early intervention for children with special needs from birth to the age of eight, social or educational assistance in the family as well as psychological or psychotherapeutic counselling for children, young people and families. The SIPO team works on a mobile basis throughout the country.

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## Increasing opportunities

### marie consolatrice école privée pour jeunes filles

The Marie-Consolatrice Private School (EPMC) has renewed itself. The extensive expansion and modernization work, which took three years, has been completed. In addition to the infrastructural measures, I-Pad classes have been introduced and the school management and teaching staff have launched numerous initiatives to encourage and support the students and thus prepare them for their future in the best possible way.

At the Marie-Consolatrice Private School, students are individually supported and can complete their education, which goes far beyond the requirements of the Ministry of Education, Children and Youth, in a strong community.

They can also benefit from initiatives that bring the school closer to the world of work.

Through cross-curricular lessons, internships in companies and social projects, a network is created between the school and the professional world.

To further promote the initiative and entrepreneurial spirit of our students, we participated in the “Entrepreneurial School” project as a pilot school in 2016 and have been part of the network of entrepreneurial schools since then.

In 2020, EPMC won the “Entrepreneurial School Awards” for the third time.

elisabeth handicap cares for people with intellectual disabilities in two residential and care centres in Betzdorf and Mondorf-les-Bains, as well as in two assisted living facilities in Roodt/Syre and Niederanven.

Our teams are committed to facilitate the residents' greatest possible participation in the life of society.

We work closely together to ensure that the people entrusted to us find here a second home in which they feel safe and comfortable. We accompany them on their way to more independence in everyday life and support them in leading a self-determined life.

Together with our teams of educators, psychologists and medical and paramedical professionals, we develop an individual life plan for and with each person we care for. This results in a holistic care that is regularly adapted to the current situation of the person we support thus enabling them to develop their individuality.

Our work is based on the principles of quality of life, normalisation, self-determination and participation in society. It creates the conditions for active progress towards inclusion.

In our day care, we offer both individual and group support. In our special day care centres and therapeutic workshops in Betzdorf and Mondorf-les-Bains, we work according to the concept of the AIB (Akademie für Inklusive Bildung- Academy for Inclusive Education), which promotes the inclusion of people with intellectual disabilities.

# Helping people live their lives



elisabeth senior offers its services in three integrated centres for senior citizens (CIPA) in Berbourg, Bettembourg and Luxembourg City, as well as in its care home in Diekirch.

Our centres for the elderly are places of life, where the combination of a hotel, social and care culture makes it easier for each resident to settle into their new home. Here we support them in maintaining their existing contacts and making new ones.

Our approach to care is person-centred and focused on individual expectations, with the aim of contributing to the well-being of the residents, regardless of their degree of dependence.

Empathetic interest in the resident's personality, respect for his or her self-determination, professionalism, interdisciplinarity, and shared responsibility are fundamental elements in developing a relationship of trust. This

trust is an indispensable factor in accompanying the individual journey through the life stage of old age, which by definition is an end-of-life stage, during which appropriate, transparent and sensitive communication with the resident and his or her family is essential.

The close cooperation of our teams enables professional and multidisciplinary care that takes into account all facets of Bien-être and guarantees quality of life until the last moment.

In our institutions, at all times, each resident can live his or her life according to his or her own convictions and with dignity.

## Central Management

The organization of the elisabeth group is the responsibility of the company Apollonia S.A., which is accredited as a social impact company. It has a dual task:

- It ensures the coordination and management of all the entities of the elisabeth group, i.e. Anne asbl, Claire asbl, Marie asbl, as well as Yolande asbl, Yolande COOP sis and the social impact company elisabeth4inclusion sàrl.
- it offers support and consultancy services to all the institutions of the elisabeth group so that they can benefit from a complete and competent administrative service.

This approach of relying on a centralised administration makes it possible to combine effectiveness and savings.

The managers of the institutions thus spend less time on administrative tasks and can concentrate more on their core mission.

Apollonia S.A. S.I.S. groups together the human resources, accounting, management control and IT departments, as well as the culture, religion and traditions department, the communication department, the quality department, the internal control department and the legal department.

Apollonia S.A. does not make any profit, the company charges its services to the different companies of the elisabeth group according to a proportional distribution key and thus covers its costs.

A specialized team from our Child and Family Support Services (SIPO) is trained to assist families in their homes.

A big part of our work is funded by the Luxembourg state, but not all of it, unfortunately...

In order to achieve sustainable results, we do not limit our actions to what is strictly necessary at a particular time.

On the contrary, we develop numerous projects and talk openly about shortcomings.

Whether it's in terms of infrastructure, equipment, staffing or the training needs of our employees.

For example, through our foundation we regularly seek additional funds for specific actions, training and therapies.

We demand high standards from our services and are committed to giving the people we work with the individual support and assistance they really need to feel safe and well.

And to live an assertive life as independently as possible.

- the promotion, support, safeguarding and creation of institutions for the reception, accommodation and care of children and young people, the elderly, dependent persons and persons with disabilities, and educational structures, as well as the promotion of social, cultural and religious support for the persons accommodated there;
